- **September 15-16** Unitus is participating in El Grito Portland in collaboration with Point West Credit Union. This community celebration at the Rose Quarter Commons in Portland brings together local community resources, artists, food vendors, and artisans.
- **September 16** Unitus is sponsoring the <u>Hispanic Heritage Month Breakfast</u> in Salem. The event brought together influential Hispanic leaders, business owners, and community members to network and highlight opportunities for continued support, partnership, and connection.

- **September 30** Unitus will celebrate its Bilingual Teachers Scholars cohort at Western Oregon University with a welcome breakfast. This Unitus program funds educational costs for 8 students to become bilingual K-12 teachers in Oregon. **Members of the media are welcome to attend.*
